

MISSIONARY UPDATE

\rightarrow Jeff & Shenv Walker **Fellowship International Mission**

HOLA Alderwood friends! We are excited about what God is doing here in Aquascalientes. Saturday evening, December 10th, we had our first evangelistic event towards starting a new church plant and towards our daughter Julie starting her after school program in the same area of the city. We held the event in a building Julie just started renting for the after school program. We called the event a "Family Christmas Festival". It was a lot like a typical Harvest Fest with lots of booths or games so the kids could win candy. Then the second hour was an evangelistic Christmas Program with a few Christmas songs, an object lesson (like Gospel Magic) of a cross making a glass of water turn from black (representing man's sin) to clear (representing salvation and forgiveness through accepting Christ as ones' personal Savior).

The program closed with a Paint Board Talk on the story of the first Christmas and how Christ provided salvation for all who believe. I (Jeff) recently bought a bright LED black light that works with fluorescent paints. I was able to use the fluorescent light for the first time for this Paint Board Talk and it went real well. We turned off all the lights, and the kids were quiet and entertained by the bright fluorescent light and paints. We had over 100 kids present, plus about 30 adults or older youth who were watching after their kids. The next step will be doing another kids club meeting in January and start visiting doorto-door to get to know the families better, and offer family counseling and Bible Studies in their homes. Pray for the Lord to continue to open up doors for the planting of more churches in Mexico. During this Christmas holiday, besides having our youngest daughter, Tiffany, home from Moody Bible Institute, we will be hosting two sisters (Paola, 7 years old and Lupita, 14 years old) from the government orphanage here in Aguascalientes. Julie and Sheny have been volunteering at this orphanage. They will be with us from Dec. 19th through Jan. 1st. Pray that we can give them a loving home for those days, and that we can share with them the love of Christ, and that they will open up to Jesus as their personal Savior. 
