MISSIONARY UPDATE

→Arlene Sorenson **OMF International** Dear Alderwood Family:

Thank you for your fellowship and faithful support! By God's grace, the encouragement of my OMF mission leaders and the faithful prayers and generous gifts of the family of God, a new chapter of my life has begun. I have started my new "member care" ministry! Preparation for this ministry took a long time but the Lord did not seem to be in a hurry. He let me experience a lot of "member care" myself as part of His training! This included being in a Life Group, Sunday school classes, and fellowship with many of you at Alderwood. Some of my prayer partners have become great role models for effective "member care"! Now it is time to pass on His encouragement to the Diaspora Returnee Ministries (DRM) team of OMF missionaries working with Asian students in the US and Canada.

Nearly all of the DRM team members have previously served with OMF International in Asia. They are now called to work with Asians studying in North America -- to introduce them to Christ, disciple them and prepare them to return to Asia as committed Christians. Since OMF works in Asia, our goal is to build networks so when students return to their homeland they can be connected to the church and other Christians. They need this encouragement and follow- up. Work among Asian students is challenging. It takes time to establish rapport and the preparation of their hearts to hear the Gospel message. Thankfully our team has experience in Asian culture and can speak Chinese or another Asian language. All of these factors help, but we are cast on the Holy Spirit to open their hearts. In the future I will share stories and prayer requests so we can be a part of this great ministry together. I won't be directly involved in student ministry, but with prayer and encouragement of the missionary team working with them. My ministry of "member care" is summed up in this blessing: "May our Lord Jesus Christ Himself and God our Father, who loved us and by His grace gave us eternal encouragement and good hope, encourage your hearts and
