MISSIONARY UPDATE

→Bruce and Carol Ingram

ACTION International

We thank God for YOU, your prayers and support in partnership with Christ and the ministry of pastor training worldwide! *Yes, you will be enriched in every way so that you can always be generous. And when we take your gifts to those who need them, they will thank God (2 Corinthians 9:11).* Bruce conducted Biblical **Training of Trainers in India January 21-February 5**. One brother shared that he and his family hid in the night to escape being killed because he is a follower of Christ and two of his houses were destroyed. In spite of the persecution, he has seen 19 churches planted and is leading 18 mentor groups for multiplying disciples. By the power of the Holy Spirit, Christ is building His Church and the gates of hell will not prevail against it. Church planters from Nepal and Orissa state were revived and widows of martyred pastors are being restored. Micro-business training was given for 30 pastors' wives for nationally led and sustained ministries. It felt like being with the church of Acts 3-8. May God give us some of what they have spiritually! **Pray for:** the church in India to be filled with the Holy Spirit in the face of persecution, and for India to not become a Hindu state.

We coordinated and helped teach sessions for the field preparation for seven new ACTION missionaries during **Orientation April 24-28**. They were eager to apply what they learned and built significant meaningful relationships.

Pray for: the Lord of the harvest to send out workers (**Luke 10:2**).

Uganda Ministry April 28-May 16. While conducting Biblical training for leaders, Bruce also visited a new Sudanese refugee camp. It has only been open a month and already has 10,000 refugees. 2,800 arrive weekly and 400 sleep in plastic covered shelters. A total of 800,000 refugees are in Uganda. **Pray for the possible ministry at the refugee camp of:** children's clubs, Bible studies, pastor training and church planting.

Pray for preparation and provision for Bruce to conduct pastor training in Ethiopia July 27-August 12 and Peru November 9-21.
