→**Ryan and Diana Cleveland Cru (formerly Campus Crusade for Christ)**

Dear Alderwood Family,
Diana, Abby, Josh, and I have been in our new home for about a month now and are excited to continue to serve the Lord with Cru in His mission locally and to the world. As of this past week, Diana has transitioned (within Cru) from the Campus Ministry to Cru City, and will be starting a new direct evangelistic ministry to international and immigrant families in the greater Seattle area, starting here in the growing international community right in our own back yard. Diana's vision is to impact the nations from this community in which the Lord is already opening up door after door. The Lord is already at work, as demonstrated with our friend Mikyung placing her faith in Christ about a month ago (for more on that go to clevelandcru.com).

For me, I am still serving in the Campus Ministry. This past school year through the Campus Ministry of Cru, **we saw 1,534 students across the country place their faith in Christ!** Glory to God! Please pray that the Lord continues to bring people in to a saving relationship with Himself as students and Cru missionaries take the Gospel all over the world this summer through our Summer Mission Program. We offer summer missions to over 150 Global and 50 U.S. locations, anywhere from 1-12 weeks in length.

This summer we will be traveling as a family to Cru17, our bi-annual U.S. Staff Conference which takes place July 17-24. **Pray for our missionaries and our leaders** as they cast vision for the future of Cru so that we would continue to become even more effective in our part in giving everyone in the world an opportunity to say yes to Jesus! Abby is doing really well and is finishing up 5th grade and will be transitioning to middle school next year. This past year she started playing the viola, which she loves. Josh is also doing great and will be in 4th grade in the fall. His current passion (aside from the Lord) is Star Wars, Legos, and of course... Star Wars Legos. Diana and I are doing well and look forward to finishing unpacking from the move!
