→Kevin & Alina Beach Fellowship International Mission

Greetings in the Lord from Mexico! The last four months here have been like a ride at a theme park...Kevin & Alina describe them as Matthew 28:19 says: "Go, therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit. Teaching them to obey all that I have commanded you." Ialesia Biblica Ministerio de Vida Nueva (New Life Bible Church) is growing. It is exciting to see people recognize their need for God. And because the church has been growing we have had a problem, a good problem. Children. We ran out of space! Three different classes in one small room is chaotic! We have been building two new classrooms in back of the converted office space we rent for church. As the church grows, it also brings new challenges and needed discernment that believers here catch a VISION for the MISSION strategy to assure they are following Jesus. For example, guiding new believers in discipleship so they grow and mature, and be true followers of Jesus, is the most challenging. A huge thank you to Pastor Brad for coaching Kevin in the challenges of a church plant. They are experiencing the success because of his wise counsel.

The Rehab Center Ministry here is a very present ministry need...even overwhelming. We could spend all of our time there. This is a very dark place where the gospel light is being turned on. Every Tuesday Kevin holds a two hour church service where he has the freedom to preach Christ crucified for the remission of their sins. Many have come to a saving knowledge of Christ. Kevin baptized 19 believers in March! Family news: Alina flew to Seattle to attend Taylor's graduation last weekend.
