MISSIONARY UPDATE

Pioneer Bible Translators

Dear Alderwood family,
We thank you for your prayers and support! We also delight in updating you on what God is doing. Our family is transitioning to working among the people we serve in the refugee camps. We ask you to pray for wisdom and guidance as we gather God's vision for who will be involved, and how to structure translating the Bible with refugees and those who are still back in our African hometown, like our faithful co-translator.
To be honest, this transition has been hard for us. We have said goodbye to personal dreams and goals. Thankfully, we get to fill the space with God's dream and plan for our family and this translation. This transition has included figuring out how to live and work in a different country. One would think that there were clear ways of getting a visa permit to work. It took Breanna a year and a half to get the permit. Praise God we have successfully obtained it!
God has been faithful to push the translation forward, even when we feel stuck in the mud. He has opened the door for us to fly our co-translator, Silas* to our house here to do work on the book of Genesis. Also, Dave has flown to our African hometown to work with Silas* quite a few times. Next month he will fly there to hopefully finish up the draft of the book of Genesis! This book has been at the point where it needs to be checked and then printed for almost a year. Slowly, through tedious weeks of visits by Silas, it is close to being done. This book has amazing stories that help build people's understanding of the New Testament. Who was Abraham? We learned a lot about translating tough words like "captain of the bodyguard" when there is only chief and chief's assistant in the language. Please pray for us as Dave travels to work with Silas to finish up Genesis this month!
Please also pray for more monthly financial supporters to come on board. We need \$500/month more to be back to our budget. Please pray for wisdom in developing ways to train pastors and translators so that the word of God impacts people's lives.

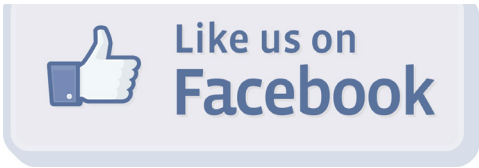
