
**R**ecently arrived from the Philippines, two sisters, who'd finished a two-year term, stayed a short time. Later, I enjoyed having a young missionary gal begining her furlough from the Philippines.

**A**ll were in awe of God's marvelous workings. among the very poor families and kids they ministered to. Thanks, ACC's Selah class, for welcoming Catie to share a bit of her life among the coastal villagers that had been devastated by the super typhoon a few years back. She immersed herself in the community, learned the language, gained respect of even would-be opposers, trained and worked beside neighbor ladies to make nourishing breakfasts each morning for 60+ malnourished children before they went to school at 7am. Helping each to memorizie the week's Bible verse was part of the "meal". Part of her home is also available for after school tutoring, games, Bible lessons and more. New believers resulting from the neighborhood adult Bible studies she leads have been funneled into a little church in another area.

**Y**ES! It IS indeed worth it...being in the "Home Office" end of missions!! My little part in helping in the financial department and hosting seems so insignificant, but when our International Short Term & Intern Director shared his report this week, it thrilled my heart! Some from just this summer included: a mother-daughter duo to Nepal; six Biola students five weeks in Nepal; three interns for four month stints in Brazil; a NC high school Spanish teacher served in the slums of Bogota; five nursing interns helped at *Shalom Birthing Home* in a very impoverished area near Manila. Others sent out were from OR, Moody Bible

Institute/Spokane, and Lynden, WA. Helping to fulfill the Great Commission! Praising our LORD for the health He gives and for great encouragers, like YOU!!
