Don't you love going to Christmas concerts and watching the conductor and the musicians as they make awesome music together? It is fascinating and enjoyable! In a way, they picture how God orchestrates the details of our lives and works in His Church around the world! The word "orchestrate" means "to organize or plan something that is complicated." This word has come to mind often recently when I consider how the Lord has been working in my life, in my friends, and in our church.


Last month I was privileged to attend a conference in the UK where over 100 members of the team I serve with gathered for six days. We represented 13 different nationalities serving in 20 different countries. It was good to be together with my teammates who will receive the member care newsletters which I am assigned to write. Some are singles or couples working on their own without other teammates.

At conference I heard stories of God's orchestration in their lives. Some examples are: A German man met his Chinese wife at Bible college in Canada and are now reaching Chinese for Christ in Germany. The Lord is using an Asian couple in Kenya to lead Chinese businessmen to Christ. A retired British couple, who served in Thailand and Cambodia for many years, is now pouring their lives into Thai people all over the

Another definition of orchestrate is "activity requiring action by more than one person." To me this speaks of our total dependence upon the Lord. As in an orchestra, each of us has a part to play but we are privileged to live under the direction of our Lord who is all-knowing and trustworthy. Our conference speaker taught on The Abundant Life (John 15) and reminded us of the importance of setting aside time to spend with God instead of always being busy for God.
