MISSIONARY UPDATE

→ Ryan and Diana Cleveland Cru (formerly Campus Crusade for Christ) Dear Alderwood Family.

In our last update to ACC, we shared how excited we were for Diana's new role with Cru working to reach immigrants and internationals in the North Seattle area. I, too, have some exciting news to share!

This fall I accepted a new role in Cru, serving as the National Leadership Development & HR Director for a part of the Campus Ministry called Valor. Valor is Cru's ministry to ROTC Cadets. Midshipmen, and Veterans (just like I was!) on universities all across the United States. This is an amazing opportunity to help impact the world for Christ through our nations' military. The strategic value in reaching military leaders for the Kingdom is paramount. I personally came to know the Lord through an officer I served with in the Navy! The best way I can describe my new role is to say that I am responsible to ensure "mission readiness" for all our Valor missionaries. This includes recruiting, new missionary onboarding, team allocation, ongoing training and development, theological development, team health, and missionary care.

Diana continues to see the Lord bring fruit to her ministry. Recently she had one of our neighbors, Heejin, over for tea. As they talked through each point, much to Diana's surprise Heejin had already understood the Gospel message, but she didn't how to receive Christ! When Diana explained that all she needed to do was pray, she excitedly bowed her head and prayed a heartfelt prayer to invite Christ into her life! Praise God!
