1. The gospel is bigger than a place, a culture, or an institution.

Matthew 24:1-3

2. The gospel spreads through suffering, not conquest. Matthew 24:4-13

3. The gospel will be preached to all people. Matthew 24:14

Sermon Questions:

1. After hearing Pastor Steve's message, what challenged your thinking about missions?

2. Read **Matthew 24:1-14**. What does Jesus say here that creates a sense of urgency for sharing the gospel?

Are there any situations in your relational world where personal difficulties or cultural issues might serve as a door for sharing the gospel? Explain.

3. How are you currently involved in spreading the gospel personally, in your community, and around the world?

4. The Gospel of Christ must first change us personally before God can use us. How has the gospel changed your character, motivations, or goals?

What is God presently working on in your life to change you?

5. Read **Matthew 24:14**. We all have different gifts and abilities from God to be used by Him in spreading the gospel. How can you use your talents, gifts, and abilities right now to take the gospel to the whole world?

This might conflict with our values and priorities in some way. What priorities are you willing to modify to help make that happen?
