The Power and Grace for a Second Chance
1 Corinthians 15:3-8; 1 Peter 1:3

Sermon Questions:

1. Have you ever failed a friend or had a friend fail you? What was that experience like?
2. Read **John 21:1-19**. By this time Peter had seen the risen Jesus at least twice. What do you think Peter may have been feeling or thinking about his relationship with Jesus?
3. Compare this story with **Luke 5:1-11**. Why do you think Jesus repeated this miracle now (**John 21:5-7**)? How do you think it may have affected Peter?
4. In the presence of the other disciples, Jesus asked Peter three times if he loved Him. Why do you think He did this?

What would you say if Jesus asked you, “Do you love Me?” How would you feel? What would you think or say?

5. What do you think Jesus meant by “Do you love me more than these?” (**John 21:15**)

If Jesus asked you that same question, what might He be referring to in your life?

6. What is significant about Jesus’ command to Peter in **John 21:19** and **22**?
7. Everyone has failed Jesus at some point. Some more than others. How does Jesus’ interaction with Peter speak to your relationship with the Lord?
