1. Submitting to the Church FOR Christ

"Submit yourselves for the Lord's sake to every human institution..."
(1 Peter 2:13, NASB)

Functional:	a distinguishing of our roles and the work we are called to
	do (1 Peter 2:14-3:7)
Relational:	a loving acknowledgment of another's value as a person
	(Philippians 2:1-4)
Reciprocal:	a mutual, humble cooperation with one another
	(Ephesians 5:21)
Universal:	an acknowledgment by the church of the all-encompassing
	lordship of Jesus Christ (1 Peter 2:13)

Definition: Submission is voluntarily cooperating with someone, first out of love and respect for God and then out of love and respect for that person.

2. Submitting to the Church LIKE Christ

"Your attitude should be the same as that of Jesus Christ." (Philippians 2:5, NIV)

3. Submitting to the Church IN Christ

"For the eyes of the Lord are [looking favorably] upon the righteous" (1 Peter 3:12, AMP)
