MISSIONARY UPDATE

\rightarrow **D.C.** *aka "Lvdia"* **ACTION International, Asia** Dear Family & Friends,

Happy New Year! I am praying that the Lord has challenged you to step out of your comfort zone this year and trust Him for amazing work that He can do through you, if you are willing! The Lord is stretching me this year. After 15 years of serving in India, we must leave due to the decrease in work visas. It breaks my heart, but I know that God doesn't allow these things without a purpose. The actual leave date is sometime between March-May. Pending is the final adoption of Joshua which is basically pre-approved...we are just waiting on a final clearance from Child Welfare where he was abandoned.

So, what's next? Once in the US, we will take a month of much needed rest. Working in the red-light district is a daily journey in watching women and children in abusive, hopeless situations. Warfare is also rampant there. Then we will spend time in prayer and research to see where God would want us next. I have already been doing some research and have some appointments in Thailand in February to visit for possible future work. The door to India may re-open in a year. I am praying that wherever God sends me, that I will be able to continue the ministry in human trafficking education, prevention, and helping those who have survived the atrocities through the healing process. We are asking that if you currently support us, that you will continue to do so the first six months that we are back in the U.S. We hope God will have opened the doors to our new assignment by then, but we are on His agenda and time schedule. So please keep us in prayer for the following...




