SANCTITY OF HUMAN LIFE SUNDAY

When Kelli came to the Pregnancy Resource Center (PRC) for a pregnancy test, Advocate Emma didn't think there was anything unusual about the intake form. Kelli was married with children, which usually means the woman simply wants confirmation of her pregnancy. Shortly into the appointment Kelli shared a significant twist to her story: the father of the baby is a man with whom she had an affair. Ashley came to the PRC as a single mom, homeless,

Ashley came to the PRC as a single mom, nomeless, unemployed, and facing an unplanned pregnancy. With the baby's daddy'out of the picture', Ashley was seriously lacking the support many of us might take for granted.

Women who come to the PRC fall into one of three categories, 'likely to parent', 'abortion-vulnerable' or 'abortion-minded'. An abortion-minded client is one who is determined to have an abortion. An abortion-vulnerable client is uncertain, but faces many challenges that make them vulnerable to choosing abortion. Kelli and Ashley were definitely abortionvulnerable.

Half the women who come into the PRC are abortionvulnerable or abortion-minded. Women come to the PRC facing challenges ranging from an unsupportive boyfriend or family to pregnancy from rape or sextrafficking.

The generous support of everyone at Alderwood Community Church has provided the PRC Advocates and nurses with the specialized training to serve and support women who, like Kelli and Ashley, face unique challenges.

The specialized training helped the PRC achieve a dramatic increase last year. In 2017, the PRC had an increase of 154% of clients who were either abortion-vulnerable or abortion-minded who chose life, and carried their babies to term. Kelli and Ashley are among those women who chose life for their babies! The PRC faces some unique challenges of its own in 2018. • Protection from Washington State anti-PRC

- legislation which seeks to hamper and inhibit communication with clients.
- Becoming accredited with the nationally recognized Accreditation Association for Ambulatory Health Care (AAAHC) this summer. AAAHC accreditation is a sign that a health care organization meets or exceeds nationally-recognized standards.

On this Sanctity of Human Life Sunday, the PRC is asking each ACC family to take a baby bottle home. Fill the bottle with coins, cash, or checks (made out to PRC), and bring the bottle back by February 18th. Last year over \$24,000 was raised. The goal this year is \$30,000! Because of your continued support, women are overcoming challenges and babies are being saved!
