MISSIONARY UPDATE

→Jesse & Hannah Van Gorkom EMI (Engineering Ministries International)

Greetings from Uganda, East Africa! BIG news!!! We are expanding the EMI Workshop! Let me give you a quick overview of the work that we do. I (Jesse) help manage the Workshop for EMI Uganda. We fabricate steel and timber products to support the construction management and design projects that EMI takes on for other ministries throughout the country. Right now our products include: windows, doors, cabinets, wardrobes, hand rails, and pre-fabricated steel wall sections. Last year around this time our workshop here in Kampala employed three Ugandan craftsmen. Now, barely one year later, our number has increased to 14!

Our main goal is to build into the lives of the men who work with us. However, God has also provided more fabrication work than we can handle through the various EMI Uganda design and construction management projects.

We have already outgrown our existing work space, so EMI is beginning the planning and fundraising process to construct a new workshop that will enable us to employ up to 40 guys, with increased capacity for projects, training, and discipleship! Want in on the adventure?? EMI is organizing a fund-raising climb up Mt. Kilimanjaro, Tanzania, this January and you're welcome to join! Hannah and I are doing well and staying very busy. Hannah is handling payroll for the Workshop and is training one of the workshop guys to help. This means she comes into the office with me at least twice a week!

I have been helping to lead a discipleship group in our office, as well as organizing (and usually leading) a Bible study with the guys in the workshop once a week. On the job welding and fabrication training is always on-going. I enjoy being able to train and work with the guys in the shop, I am always learning from them as well! Please continue to keep us in your prayers. There are a few big changes coming up for the workshop. Pray for wisdom and guidance as we

head into the next several months. And please pray that our friendship with neighbors and our church family here in Uganda would both continue to grow. Jesse & Hannah
