MISSIONARY UPDATE

→Cory & Kristine Cramer Thrive International Missions, Albania

To our ACC Family,
God bless you on this day of worship! We praise the Lord for giving us fellowship through His Son today even as we are so far away.
For those of you who may not know, we work with a church plant in the city of Pogradec, Albania. As we approach our 4th anniversary of living in Albania, my wife Kristine and I cannot believe all the lives we have seen transformed and how the Lord has grown the church here. After years of growth, moving from location to location, our church has found a permanent home in the center of our city. This happened because of your generosity and partnership. This church now has room, not only for larger services, but space for ministries to serve the church and the community here. Construction is under way and we hope to start services there this summer.
This year has been a year of spiritual growth and depth. Our entire team has been in country the whole year and so our ability to do more Bible Studies, discipleship and planning has given us more good fruit. As I prepare to preach the final message from our *Sermon on the Mount* series, we are praying for more people to enter the narrow path and make Christ their Savior.

This summer we will welcome two teams from Alderwood. It is my prayer that this summer we would have greater evangelism than any summer before. More short-term missionaries are coming, more nationals are taking part in the Great Commission and our experience has given us more wisdom reaching the lost. Please pray for all those coming from ACC to serve in Albania this summer.

Our family is growing way too fast. Our oldest Shiloh (4), is in preschool and learning Albanian simply by hearing it every day. We are so proud of her bravery to walk into a room where she couldn't understand a word. But I am sure within time she will be teaching me. Taliah (3) starts preschool this June...suddenly we have two big girls! Jude (1) is growing, walking, and becoming less baby, more boy. Our kids are the best, and like most parents, we are obsessed with them.

We love and miss you, and plan to be with you in early October. Pray for the Church of Pogradec as we celebrate with you today!
