This is an exciting time of year for us in Albania. We are preparing for summer camps and are thrilled that ACC is again sending two teams to help us reach young people for Christ. Also, at the beginning of June we received approval for the renovations on what will be our new church building. For several months we were at a standstill with getting permits and were not feeling very optimistic at all. However, in a matter of weeks we received permits above and beyond what we expected! Praise the Lord. Teammates are also finishing up work on a coffee shop that will be a source of jobs for some within the church and a source of income for the church to help it become more self-sustaining.

I (Chad) am working to develop our deacon ministry. We are a young church, so do not yet have people who are ready to be considered deacons, but we want to begin to focus on developing those who are teachable and desire to serve the church in various ways. Both Jess and I are also participating in developing our mercy/ benevolence ministry. There are many in need of material help here, but we want to respond in a way that first seeks to win people for Christ and secondly does not create deeper dependence. We are now gathering those within the church with convictions to help the materially poor and developing ways that they can hopefully do this most effectively.
