MISSIONARY UPDATE

→ Greg & LuAnn Lyons Global Surge, Manila God continues to open doors for our ministry in Cambodia!

For many years, we have been ministering in Cambodia from the Philippines. We have sent in teams to do Evangelistic camps as well as medical and sports camps. Doing this helped to open doors to start churches.

Eventually, we have sent our own missionaries from our Global Surge team in Manila. Churches have been started and are doing very well! We continue to train and prepare leaders from Manila to send to Cambodia.

Additionally, we bought a Buddhist School in Phnom Penh and converted it to a Christian School! Most of the student body has decided to follow Christ as their personal Savior! In addition, family members are also being reached through this effort. As ministry progresses in Cambodia, the need for trained leaders becomes greater. The Gospel is flowing in this nation! Cambodia is numbered in the top fastest growing Christian communities in the world. In 1994, the Christian population was estimated at less than 1% of the total population. The main religion was Buddhism. Today, the Christian population is nearing 4%. God's hand is moving.

Recently, I was installed as President of the Highlands Bible College in Piknil Province, Cambodia. The Rawlings Foundation founded the college many years ago, but in recent times, the ministry has declined. I was asked to step in, bring leadership, academic excellence, and grow the college.

We now have a new set of freshmen students. We are expecting the college to grow from 37 to 100 soon. The Global Missionary Clearinghouse missionaries that are already engaged on the field will assist as volunteer professors for the college. In June, Highlands Bible College graduated 17 students with three-year Bible degrees. We will bring the college to a full Bachelor of Science in Biblical Studies degree level in the near future. Having Biblically trained men and women ready to

go out and share Christ with their own countrymen
