Sermon Questions:

How can your group help and support in your responsibility and your privilege as an ambassador of Christ?

5. V.21 describes an exchange God has made. What has been exchanged?

Was it a fair deal for both parties? Why/why not?

How does this exchange affect the way you see your role as Christ's ambassador?

6. Since God has appointed you an ambassador of Christ, where would you like to go?
