→ Dan & Toshiko Lockwood International Students Inc. - U of Oregon

Happy New Year, Alderwood Family! Thank you for keeping my family and me in your thoughts and prayers. Once my own semester of schooling finished, Christmas break became more relaxed and enjoyable. In addition to a fun, white elephant gift exchange with students, I reunited with an international University of Oregon alumni whom I've known for 13 years.

At the age of nine or ten, Moussa* was exposed to a world-renown economist from Ivory Coast, an African country bordering his own. This seed of inspiration moved Moussa to dream of one day working for the International Monetary Fund. (I know, a pretty strange and specific dream for a ten year-old!) Moussa and I met at the University of Oregon in 2006, when he studied math and economics and was an international student leader.

A busy undergrad, Moussa nevertheless recalled attending one of our apple cider press parties. We had many, mostly brief, conversations over the years. Although, or, rather, because he is a Muslim, our conversations often quickly led to the subject of Jesus. Though at one time it seemed I had brought him very close, I couldn't "make the horse drink." I wished we had more time.

Eventually Moussa went to the University of Washington, where he earned his PhD. Only months after accepting a college teaching job, he recently got the call that he'd been accepted to work in Washington D. C. – for the International Monetary Fund! He visited Eugene over winter break and we caught up over coffee. He told me this job was the last and greatest dream on his list. When we wrapped up, he actually asked me to pray for him!

Other inspiring things are happening, too, within Moussa's family, including three of his four siblings who presently live in the U.S.
Thank you for praying for and financially partnering with our ministry to students like my friend Moussa. Please continue to pray still more. Your prayers avail[eth] much, your labor in the Lord is not in vain.


