SANCTITY OF HUMAN LIFE SUNDAY

"What brings you in today?" That's all Charlene had to ask the young woman before the tears began streaming from Tara's eyes. Tara had been to the Pregnancy Resource Center (PRC) a year ago, but had chosen to abort that pregnancy. Now, as she sat across from Client Advocate Charlene, she couldn't even begin the appointment without sobbing at the memory of a year ago. Charlene knew what Tara needed more than anything at this moment, forgiveness. With Tara's permission, Charlene carefully walked her through God's plan of redemption. Tara cried again as Charlene explained that Christ's resurrection proved He had the power to remove her sin and guilt. Just as last year, Tara faces an unplanned pregnancy. But this time she chose life – life for her baby and life in Christ for herself. And, thanks to the support of ministry partners around Snohomish County, Tara will have the PRC walking alongside her. Please pray for Tara as she begins her new life in Christ, and for strength and peace as she prepares for her new baby.

The new year will bring many new things for Tara, and for the PRC! Over Christmas break, thanks to a generous gift from Alderwood, we have a remodeled lobby; new furniture, paint, wall hangings, and reception desk! Such a beautiful environment to welcome women facing difficult decisions.

The new year also begins our aggressive client marketing initiative; "geo fencing", Google Plus, social media marketing strategy, and advertisements throughout the county. We want our name to be the first that a woman thinks of when she faces an unplanned pregnancy. The PRC provides over 3,000 services to women and families each year; with our new marketing initiative we want to see that number climb even higher in 2019. The new year brings facilities challenges as well. Please pray for the Center as we consider replacing three HVAC units, the repair and resurfacing of our parking lot, and improvement of our landscaping. Pray as well that our efforts to reach more women with life-affirming services and the good news of the Gospel are successful through 2019. On this Sanctity of Human Life Sunday, the PRC is asking each ACC family to take a baby bottle home. Fill the bottle with coins, cash, or checks (made out to PRC), and bring the bottle back by February 17th. 
