→ Jesse & Hannah Van Gorkom EMI (Engineering Ministries International)

Hello to our Alderwood Church family!
In our last update I mentioned our hopes to expand our fabrication/training workshop here with Engineering Ministries International in Uganda. Fundraising has been moving along, and we have been finalizing construction drawings. We hope to begin construction within a few months! I also mentioned the EMI fundraising Kili-climb scheduled for the end of January... there's less than two weeks until our team leaves for the climb!

Please pray the new workshop expansion will go smoothly, and that everyone on our climbing teams would make it to the top of Kilimanjaro safely!

My position as Workshop Manager keeps me very busy. We have two large projects we are trying to wrap up and four more large projects we are ramping up for this year! Hannah is also busy re-vamping our workshop financial procedures to allow for continued growth and effective ministry where God has placed us.

Please pray for wisdom as we both have a lot of work to do over the next few months, and large parts of it (especially for me) are new territory. Also that our focus on discipleship would not get sidelined for the need of productivity! And finally, we want to share this news with you...there will be a third Van Gorkom joining our team in April! For health and family reasons we are planning to return to the U.S. at the beginning of March, with tentative plans to head back to Uganda at the beginning of May. We will be in Michigan during this time, but will be unable to visit Washington.

Please pray for safety and health as our family enters into this new phase of our life and ministry. As they say here in our Ugandan Church family: "God is Good. All the Time. And that is His Nature!" Pray we never stop believing in the Goodness of our loving God!
