	C.	Create a game plan
		(1) Ask Questions to start or move the conversation toward spiritual matters. (Matthew 10:16; Colossians 4:5-6)
		(a) Principles:*Never make a statement when a question will do.*Whoever makes the claim bears the burden of proof.*Make it your goal to put a stone in their shoe.
		(b) Ask Clarifying Questions:*What do you mean by that?*How did you come to that conclusion?
		(2) Share your story!
		(3) Give Resources that explain who Jesus is and what he did!
		(4) Show them the gospel from the Scriptures. (1 Corinthians 15:3b-4)
