

# DAY USE CAMPERS FAQ



## WILL I BE ASSIGNED A CAMPSITE?

No. We highly recommend joining up with a family who is overnight camping and sharing their campsite. Don't know anyone? Let us know! We'd be happy to help you connect with someone!

## WHERE DO I PARK?

You will park at the RV spots to the left of the main entrance across from the RV bathrooms. You will then walk in to the main campground area. There are limited spots available inside the campground.

## WHAT FOOD DOES WARM BEACH PROVIDE?

The camp provides nothing but the campsites. You will need to provide food for all of your meals as well as a way to cook it, whether over the campfire or a campfire stove.

## HOW DO I COOK MY FOOD?

We highly recommend bringing food that doesn't need to be cooked. However, we're all friends! Pop in to a nearby campfire and join another family for smores, cooking hot dogs, or other meals you may have brought up. Campfires are one of the best ways to meet new friends. Everyone in the campground area will be from Alderwood.

*\*Campfires must be above ground*

## IS THERE WIFI? HOW GOOD IS CELL SERVICE?

The main Warm Beach lodge does have wifi (and a gift shop), and in our experience cell service is typically average in the campground. Please make sure children 5th grade and below do not visit lodge without an adult.

## WHAT IS THERE TO DO UP AT CAMP FOR ONE DAY?

There are multiple swim times per day (usually one in the morning and one in the evening), a large looped road for bikes, basketball court, tennis court, lots of walking paths, a mini golf course, playground within walking distance, open grass fields, and lots of friends to play in the dirt with. We also have a couple group activities planned for Friday & Saturday.

## WHAT ACTIVITIES DO WE ALL DO TOGETHER?

There will swim times just for Alderwood multiple times a day (Tuesday through Saturday) and there will be a couple other organized events throughout the week.

**Friday** - a pick up game of kickball or softball in the near field and a kids scavenger hunt.

**Saturday** - group games in the far field (races by age, tug-o-war, water balloon toss) all of which culminates in a giant water fight with all of the kids. Bring squirt guns if you have them. There is a glow parade to end the night.

**Sunday morning** - donuts & Sunday service before we all pack up to leave.

\*Make sure to check the schedule while at camp for more activities and official times!

## CAN I JUST SHOW UP FOR THE DAY WITHOUT SIGNING UP?

Everyone must sign up and pay even if you are only coming up for the day. The camp charges for day use for insurance purposes and use of the facilities. You can register and pay once up at camp but we HIGHLY recommend signing up and paying ahead of time.

## HOW EARLY CAN I ARRIVE?

The camp is usually awake and people active by 9am. Our first swim is from 12:30- 2:30 so if you want to swim, make sure to arrive before then!

# WHAT SHOULD I BRING?

- Food/Drinks for all meal times + snacks
- Camping chairs
- Bikes, scooters, and other toys for the kids
- Swimsuits, towels, and anything else for the pool
- Squirt guns for the water fight on Saturday
- Warm clothes for the evening
- Garbage bags
