Dear Alderwood,
Thank you so much for your prayers. We appreciate you all so much. As you may know, Danielle has been going to in-person school since August 3rd at a private Christian School. (Arizona tax credits can

be turned into scholarships...they are a blessing for sure.) She has befriended a Navajo girl in foster care and they have become best friends. She and her sister have been placed in another home to be with their younger siblings...this required moving and a new school. They had their goodbye party at school, and during the party, she came and told me she had accepted Christ! So thankful for this! We have been praying all year, because we knew she wasn't a Believer yet. So glad that Danielle got to be a part of this, too. Some plant, some water, and some harvest. What a blessing. We will continue our prayers for her and the new placement out of town.

Dan continues at the office as he is the only one there now, and Beth goes in to help occasionally, as there are still a lot of things to be done there. It is different not going out to visit our churches, but God just gives us different ways to minister. Day of prayer has turned into conference calls. We also need to care for a couple of mission properties, including one here in Flagstaff that is in need of some repairs. Hopefully in the future people will be willing to come out again for short-term mission trips. Beth continues to lead the Moms in Prayer group at Danielle's school.

We enjoyed talking and sharing with several of you all over Zoom for the spring mission conference! So nice to connect with you! We are looking forward to the future and how God will be using us here among the Navajo. Hope you all have a blessed Resurrection season! What a blessing you all are to us!
