MISSIONARY UPDATE

Hi Alderwood,
Our prayers are often with you as you serve and love on your communities during this season. We cannot thank you enough for your support over these last nine years. Jonathan was sitting in South Sudan conversing with pastors a few weeks ago. There was hot ginger coffee on the table, and flies buzzing in the heat as they discussed what it means to minister to those suffering in their local communities. Things are so hard right now in South Sudan for so many. Our small medical clinic is experiencing record numbers of patients and the community is asking if hours can be expanded to meet basic medical needs. The answer feels hard to give, as we don't have enough staff or resources. This hurts us on many levels...how we long to be able to provide basic medical care, more thorough theological training, and basic primary education so men and women can access the Bible. We long to see our South Sudanese brothers & sisters not suffering from curable diseases, or children going hungry from lack of nutrition. Violence has caused many displaced to settle under trees exposed to the elements, as rainy season begins and malaria sets in...we wish we had easy answers to the problems surrounding the community and church. We recognize that the answers don't lie in merely providing physical assistance, but instead in coming alongside the church and seeking God with them for how God redeems for His glory. How can we help the church in South Sudan minister to their communities? What lessons does God have for all of us in suffering and caring for others?

Alderwood, as we seek God amidst great need here we are also praying for you, that as you live and work and serve others in need, God will empower you to recognize limitations and in those places seek God's story of redemption.
