Dear Alderwood Family, We thank you so much for your prayers and support for our ministry over these last months—we are seeing God working in and through us. We started helping out a ministry in Cumbres, a poorer neighborhood

on the outskirts of the city. Some ladies have been reaching out to kids for the last year, but were looking for a church to help them reach out to the adults. Rodrigo and Gris, a couple from our church, and Rafael have stepped alongside us to help us reach out to the neighborhood. We help with one service on Saturdays, and then the others also go on Wednesdays to do a Bible study and give food to those who come by. Besides being a poor neighborhood, drugs control many lives. Pray for spiritual and physical freedom for these people, that as they come to know the Lord as their Savior, they would put away drugs and alcohol and allow God to fill their voids.

We recently held a craft and dessert event for moms of one of our kids clubs in Norias. We had six moms show up (we were thrilled) and were able to share God's love with them through a devotional and craft. Afterwards they started opening up and sharing about some of the needs that the kids have and we were able to pray for God's protection over their lives. We are hoping to have a craft day regularly to draw the moms to the club and be able to continue getting to know them better and share the Gospel with them more clearly. Pray that we can continue to build relationships with the parents during the summer and that they would believe in Jesus as their Savior.
