Hello from Athens!

Life is kicking back into gear after the holidays, and we are busy preparing for the new year of ministry before us. These next four months will look rather different as the church-plant pastor, Errikos, will be in the United States working on a Master's degree through Reformed Theological Seminary in Charlotte, NC. While we will miss him and his wife, the church-plant will continue to progress with Daniel leading. Please pray for Daniel as he fills in this role, and for the church-plant in this time of temporary transition. Since September, Sarah has been in charge of the kids' ministries at the church-plant. We have both a weekly Friday night program and Sunday School. The kids love playing crazy games and enjoy interactive lessons from the Bible. Pray that the Lord would speak to each child's heart and reach into the lives of the many families we have interaction with.

There is a man named Doulis who used to be very consistent in attending the church-plant. His wife was already suffering with severe depression when he discovered he had leukemia. For many months now he has been in and out of the hospital, doing chemo treatments and not seeing many results. In fact, things seem to be getting worse. He has not been able to attend church and we are not allowed to visit him in the hospital due to Covid measures. We have been very encouraged to see him taking strength from the truths he heard about in the church-plant.
