She believed a baby would disrupt her family's life and negatively affect her older children. When asked about her faith Talia tearfully

replied, "I feel distant from God." The advocate assured Talia of God's love for her, that He walks with us through difficulties, and gives us peace. Then they prayed together. Talia was relieved when the test came back negative; a weight lifted from her.

When the advocate called to follow up Talia exclaimed, "I'm so glad you called!" She cheerfully told how God used the experience to draw her back to Him. She was grateful for the PRC, but most importantly, "I feel blessed that the Lord still loves me."

Because of you, Jesus' love shines on patients who are facing trials and feeling distant from God. Thank you for standing with us to help them see the preciousness of life and the love of God.

- Our Connexions program added virtual presentations to rave reviews from students. "I've never heard a speaker talk openly about sex like this. I know I need to make better choices."
- Our Expecting Miracles program engaged families online for birthing & parenting classes and built community through an online Mom's Support Group.

- A new room for STI testing and treatment services.
