MISSIONARY UPDATE JESSE & HANNAH VAN GORKOM

ENGINEERING MINISTRIES INTERNATIONAL



Rich & Joyce Myhre met with the Van Gorkom family recently...read their report below!

Long before they met and fell in love, Jesse and Hannah Van Gorkom were in love with the idea of overseas Christian ministry.

They first met in the east African nation of Uganda, and on a day when neither had the slightest notion of finding love. As the story goes, Hannah had spent a couple of days working in the Ugandan countryside, much of it in the searing sun, and she had skipped bathing due to an absence of hot water. On that fateful day, she had the scent of perspiration and smelly animals — specifically, goats, which she had been helping to deliver — when she met the man who would be her future husband. Rather than being put off, Jesse — who had been raised in Ethiopia, the

son of missionary veterinarians — knew at once that Hannah was a potential soulmate. "We joke that I fell in love with her because she

smelled ... stinky and of animals, and that it reminded me of the vet clinic (when I was) growing up," he said with a smile.

They were married in 2015, and today serve in Uganda with Engineering Ministries International, where they manage a fabrication workshop that provides components for buildings to be used by other mission groups.

In addition, they train, mentor and disciple the Ugandans who work in their shop and on their job sites.

With 3-year-old daughter Addi and 4-month-old son Asher, they are back for a prolonged home visit in the Seattle area. Seeing, among others, Fred and Vicki Van Gorkom, Jesse's parents, who are longtime members of the ACC family.

Despite all the comforts of American life, Jesse and Hannah are eager to return to Uganda.

"We love it (there)," Jesse said. "We want to go back as soon as God lets us."
