Garth & Sarah Fell met with the Kellums recently...read their report below!

To start the conversation, Rick and Lisa provided a brief overview of where God has taken them in their 40 years of service with Cru (formerly,

Campus Crusade for Christ), a journey that includes time in both the United States and France.

Rick and Lisa shared some examples of how God has worked through their family and the relationships they formed with students while serving in campus ministries in France.

Currently the Kellums are working through CRU City. They explained how they have been navigating the difference between the microwave of a college campus ministry and the slow cooker of neighborhood ministry. The good news - it's still about building relationships.

Finally Garth and Sarah asked where Rick and Lisa find rest and recovery in an occupation that is not 9 to 5. Flexibility is the key and a midweek hike or date night has its advantages!
