PAUL & LIZ GODWIN INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS INC.



This has been a hard letter to write. I (Liz) have not wanted to do this, but I think it is time. 51 years ago, I clearly felt God's calling on my life for missions. 36 years ago, He started to reveal His plan. Today, I am sensing it is time to retire. This will be our last

year of ministry ending in December 2022. I'd like to provide our supporters with a summary of what God has done since 1986:

14 years of Japanese homestay programs

13 years of Talk Time. 21 years of Reaching Japanese for Christ (RJC) conferences

5 years as the ISI City Director

12 years of Lynnwood International Christian Fellowship 2 years researching churches/returnee issues in Japan Multiple (13-15) short-term trips to Japan since 1995

5 years on the RJC board since its formation

5 years of RJC webinars

6 years of Japanese moms' English group

3 years of Chinese moms ESL group

Through all of this, Paul has been right there with me; engaging with students we hosted, teaching English at Talk Time, driving students' home, taking students on day trips, preparing ICF materials and leading small groups discussions to help visiting internationals see who Jesus is in the Bible. Paul always helped as needed at RJC and with the Japanese mom's English group. I am a person that likes to create and grow ministry. Honestly it has been hard to do that these last two years. First the lockdowns, then doing ICF on Zoom, then fully vaccinated students having new outbreaks of Covid (three times).

At 67 years old I don't have the physical or mental energy to plan and dream through these obstacles. Paul's Parkinson's has also continued to progress, which is disheartening to me. I do hear God's voice saying, "Occupy till I come". What does that look like moving forward? I am still seeking God's leading on that. We thank all of our supporters for your prayers and donations through these years.
