## MISSIONARY UPDATE

ROY & ELVIA SPRAGUE NORTHWEST INDEPENDENT CHURCH EXTENSION



"The Lord Working With Them..." (Mark 16:20) Roy & Elvia Sprague, were asked to

serve the Wishkah Valley Community Church in 2020 after their pastor died with cancer. They responded to this need, not knowing that 2½ years later,

they would still be serving the Church as Interim Pastor. During this time, many of the congregation have "stepped up" to serve the Church and community in a variety of ways— "the Lord working with them." The Wishkah Church began in the 1950's as a Monday School, meeting in a remodeled quanset-style building. At that time, Dave & Linda had recently trusted Christ as Savior. Today they serve the church in many ways, such as teaching Sunday school, and as an elder and deaconess. (see photos at <u>alderwood.cc/sprague</u>) When the opportunity was made known, Dan and Steve accepted the challenge to lead an outreach ministry at the Aberdeen Union Gospel Mission.

Andy & Renee, concerned for boys and girls to know Jesus, began to develop material to use in Children's Church and Vacation Bible School, and to give leadership to these opportunities of reaching and teaching children. Kassie saw the need of someone to supervise the Church's Nursery. Jean serves as a Board Member for the Heart and Hands Pregnancy Care Center in Aberdeen. Caleb, seeing the need of a permanent Pastor for the Church, has expressed his heart's desire to be used of the Lord in such a way. He has begun training and gaining experience in preaching and teaching and providing leadership.

At the same time as these people have trusted the Lord to use them in serving Him, there have been new people whose hearts God has changed, such as Marley & Cindy, who were saved this past year, and are now growing in their love for Christ and the Church.
