We thank the Lord your partnership with us in Christ's work worldwide. Bruce is mentoring national leaders in Malawi, Nigeria, Tanzania, Nepal, Pakistan and Myanmar who then teach others who teach others. We are also learning much from them.

What We Are Learning from Believers in Africa

- 1. Faith in Christ and the truth of the Gospel transforms hearts for God's glory. We provided lessons on the false teaching of the prosperity gospel and what is the true gospel of Christ. After it was taught there was a lady weeping. She was giving money to a preacher who promised she would become rich and bought objects that would heal her. But she was not getting rich or well and thought God did not love her. She said she now knows that God loves her and Christ died for her sins and she is a child of God and these are tears of joy. For God so loved the world that He gave His one and only Son, that whoever believes in Him shall not perish but have eternal life (John 3:16).
- 2. Immediate childlike faith and obedience to Christ and His word; starting mentor groups for multiplying disciples to Christ (Matthew 28:18-20). Bruce began discipling one person in Malawi which became 30, then 120, and now over 400! (2 Timothy 2:2). When Bruce visited Malawi recently, he met a young man who started 14 mentor groups and met with one of the groups of 40 people.
- 3. God pours out His Spirit upon those who witness to Christ and make disciples who multiply (Acts 1:8); accomplishing what only God can do for His glory.

Prayer For:

- 4. God's leading for Village Bible Schools in five districts for the 400 mentor group leaders and 400 Malawi pastors not able to attend Bible School.
- 5. Fruitful virtual training of 15 believers in Pakistan to go to unreached groups.
- Those trained in Nepal to begin mentor groups multiplying disciples to Christ.
- 7. Shoulder replacement surgery for Carol possibly in January.
