For the past five months I have been living in Salatiga, Central Java. I am

in the process of learning Bahasa Indonesia. I am not a natural language learner, but I have kept in mind Colossians 3:23-24 and have embraced learning this new information. For it is important to remember that we serve the Lord Christ in all that we do. But let me tell you the many ways that I have been blessed and have been able to be a blessing in my current community. I have been blessed with a beautiful house to live in for these months. During this time, I have had the chance to host many Fireside Fellowships with my fellow female MAF missionaries and the MAF bimonthly meetings. I have also been able to host a large Thanksgiving celebration and I will be hosting a Christmas party for the women of my Bible study. This study, the Salatiga International Fellowship Women's Bible Study, is in English and has helped me continue to be spiritually filled as I attend Indonesian church on Sundays.

My neighborhood has also been a blessing.
My neighbors have allowed me to speak with them in my very broken *Bahasa Indonesia* and have encouraged me in my learning. In turn, I have been able to share with my neighbors (many who are Muslim) about my reason for learning their language, including my testimony. These relationships have been an open door for me to show the love of Christ. In less than a month I will move back to Sentani, Papua, Indonesia, teaching in my missionary field. I am excited to reconnect with my students and to be a part of the Hillcrest School team. But, I will look back at my time in Salatiga with fondness.
