PREGNANCY RESOURCE CLINIC SANCTITY OF HUMAN LIFE SUNDAY



Thank you, ACC! Because of you the ministry of the Pregnancy Resource Clinic is thriving, and poised to launch more "Life-Affirming" programs. Kirk Anderson, the Clinic's new Fatherhood Program Manager is ready to launch the Fatherhood program in 2023.

For years the Clinic has believed that fathers have a voice in the pregnancy decision, they have a *heart* for their unborn baby, and they have a *future* as a well-prepared dad because of the training available at the Clinic. New father-to-be Tim came to the Clinic with his partner for an ultrasound appointment. When he saw the baby on the ultrasound he said, "I guess I need to make some changes." Tim made the decision to give up alcohol in solidarity with the mother of the baby. Pray for Kirk as he engages with new dads and encourages them to be a part of the pregnancy decision, and equips them with the tools they need to be the best man for the job of raising their baby. Carina Burks, the Clinic's new Connexions Manager is also ready to launch her program. Pray for Carina as she reaches out to middle and high school educators with sexual integrity and healthy relationship presentations. Carina's presentations aim to educate, empower, and equip students to think critically when making choices with their lives. Finally, the Clinic is working toward providing well-woman care in 2023. Well-woman care will give the Clinic more opportunities to reach into the community and build relationships with women before they might have need for pregnancy services.
