FLAGSTAFF MISSION TO THE NAVAJOS



Dear Alderwood, Every December we do Christmas outreach events on or near the Navajo reservation in churches, in some schools and at senior citizen centers. These involve lots of travel, set up, singing, puppets, sharing the gospel, giving gifts away, clean up, pack up, and more

driving...over and over again. But it's always worth it! FMN has been doing these outreaches for nearly 75 years. This past December we had 15 outreach meetings with 650 in attendance...seventeen accepted Christ as their savior and two were restored. We were happy to have Danielle's help with puppets and playing the keyboard. We have age-appropriate gifts to distribute...the people really look forward to these. For some, this could be the only gift they get this year. One woman who attended was so grateful just to receive a blanket. We appreciate those who donate towards these outreach events, making it possible to give the Navajo people items they really need. Deborah was a little girl when she attended a Christmas outreach at the church in Kayenta. Her family, like most here on the reservation, believed in spirits and witchcraft, but when Deborah heard the gospel, she knew that Jesus was the only way to heaven. Now Deborah is a grandma! She still attends the church in Kayenta and does a women's Bible study with Beth. She is also one of our volunteers at the mission and helps out at the Christmas outreaches when she is able.
