We continue to stay busy with the EMI Uganda Workshop. I have been helping The GEM Foundation, one of our ministry partners, with some design work for a playground designed specifically for children with special needs, many of whom are in

wheelchairs. The workshop is currently wrapping up work on a new assisted living home for this ministry and will be building the unique playground later this year. It's a privilege to help different ministry partners with a wide range of design/fabrication tasks. From building schools and hospitals to aircraft hangars and playgrounds! I also wanted to share a few wise words from our threeyear-old, Addi, with application thoughts from Hannah.

- While inspecting a damaged toy: Addi "I think someone had their grubby little paws on it...It was me!" Hannah - I too, can be quick to point out flaws...but not as willing to own the responsibility of them.
- While observing a dirty diaper change and thinking through what jobs we'd told her people do to take care of babies: Addi - **"I'm NOT the Wiper Person...I'm the Snuggler."** Hannah - *Hmmm, how many times have I* told God what tasks I'm willing and not willing to do for Him in life...and He's been patient every time.
- Getting outside for our typical morning explore. It's cold, rainy, and grey and has been/will be all day...for about the 7th day in a row: Addi - (Gasp!) "It's a GOOD THING we came out here RIGHT NOW!"

Hannah - A cheerful heart...how energizing...she was completely glad such a thrilling opportunity hadn't passed us by! My cheerful heart hides behind disappointment, feelings of injustice, and an overall idea that circumstances should go my way, even no rain. Not so. Grey moments are also gifts from a Father who knows the ultimate plan.

May your 2023 be a year of counting God's presence in the midst of your daily life.
