### MISSIONARY UPDATE

Dear Alderwood family,  
Let me to start by saying how grateful we are to represent you as your local missionaries! Thank you so much for your partnership! It's been just over two years since we transitioned to working with Cru City locally. Several people have asked, "what exactly is your ministry?" Allow me to answer briefly:

- 1. Reaching our immediate neighbors.** We seek to touch the lives in our neighborhood through monthly events that include soup nights, appetizer evenings, desserts, Easter brunch, and other activities. Through these we are able to build community and rapport. We have deeper relationships one-on-one with several neighbors. For example, we've been journeying with a couple, Chris & Alix, for about two years. We've been able to share the gospel with them and currently have a Bible study with them.
- 1. Partnering with Alderwood Community Church.** It is vital for Lisa and I to reach the community alongside ACC! Examples of this are: teaching a class on neighborly, facilitating a discussion on evangelism, leading a discussion on how to begin spiritual conversations during food distribution (Tuesday evenings) at the Compassion center as well as serving on the navigator team with the Compassion Center. Lisa is also coaching mentors as they reach out in the single mom Life Group ("Seen"). We're not just engaged members of the church, but also key catalysts in helping to accelerate the gospel in Lynnwood as we equip others to have a ministry where God had placed them!
- 2. Coaching/mentoring/discipling young professionals.** As mentioned, we have a heart to help others grow in their faith and to equip them to have a ministry themselves. This includes one-on-one coaching and mentoring. We are privileged to be able to have an impact in this way!

There is more, but I'll close for now. Thank you again for your partnership — it means so much to us!
