who "happened" to be nearby on the sidewalk, they successfully pushed us into the entrance of Lowes! WOW!! Thank You, Lord for the angels You sent. A good friend "rescued" us and took us home after AAA hauled away my "trusty" Focus to Bickford Ford.

Rosalinda had a specific purpose for coming...God had placed on her heart a burden for salvation for a Filipina businesswoman, living in this area, who had recently lost her husband to cancer. Rosalinda had contacted this lady through a mutual friend, inviting her to lunch near her workplace.

Bickford's call on Tuesday was bad news...they found the transmission control modular would need to be replaced. The big problem...that part has a waiting backlog of 4-9 months!!! On Wednesday the new widow told Rosalinda that she was available Saturday morning. Knowing we did not have a vehicle to be able to meet them, Rosalinda asked if she could come to my place for brunch. She agreed! My daughter brought a car for me to use, and on Friday we went grocery shopping. Rosalinda spent the rest of the day preparing Filipino delicacies! That Saturday as we finished eating, it smoothly transitioned to Rosalinda sweetly singing the very appropriate, "....Oh yes, He cares, I know He cares, His heart is touched with my grief..." Each of us then took turns reading the verses with Rosalinda ending in prayer. The tear-filled widow, followed along, then asked the LORD to come into her life!!!
