MISSIONARY UPDATE

JON & AMIE CROSS
SIM, EAST AFRICA



Amie was sitting with a person for a debrief session this week. The person described so well some of the pain in the world. They described how physical manifestations of evil are so present and physically strong that it can become hard to recognize God's goodness. Alderwood, as

you pray alongside us this month, we are asking for the many situations and stories here in East Africa, and in your homes and communities where evil is so physically present, that God will make himself known in ways that only He can, bringing redemption from brokenness.

Jonathan just returned from a trip to South Sudan where pastors asked for help in giving advice to difficult situations in the church, abuse, tribal conflict, polygamy, starvation, spiritual persecution, and extreme poverty. They wanted to know how the gospel brings hope and speaks into those hard pieces of life.

Back in Kenya, this year, Amie has listened to such hard stories of physical and sexual violence, emotional pain, grief, loss, and identity issues as she provides chaplaincy to adults and kids at the international school, in the community, and SIM and they are seeking the same thing as the pastors in South Sudan. Perhaps you too are wrestling with understanding the gospel and the hope it brings to present-day realities as well.

So we ask for prayer to better see the thin spaces of life where we can experience God's goodness in the land of the living. We ask you to join us in praying that we can be physical reminders of God's redemption in the communities and spaces we have been invited to participate in, and to hold stories of brokenness with hope for God's redemption.

We ask you to join us in praying for more missionaries to work alongside us, and for better theological training opportunities.
