MISSIONARY UPDATE

ROY & ELVIA SPRAGUE NORTHWEST INDEPENDENT CHURCH EXTENSION



In 1906, a group of believers in Christ, with a desire for a church that was committed to Biblical preaching, teaching and practice was formed on Main Street in Elma, Washington. There were numerous hitching posts lining the gravel street in front of the church building, but the people were excited to

have their own place to learn of the Lord and to worship Him.

Now almost 117 years later, this same church building has been added to and improved to meet the needs of the present congregation. Through the years, the church's name has changed several times, and is now the Grace Community Church of Elma - but the same desire remains by those who gather each week, a desire to worship their Lord and receive instruction from God's Word, and to reach out to the community with the Gospel. During the past year there have been six church members called into the Lord's presence in glory. Several others - including the pastor - have moved to Arizona for the winter, to find improved health by the drier climate. That's where Roy and Elvia come into the picture. Roy and Elvia have served with Northwest Independent Church Extension for the past 53 years (Roy as Executive Director and Elvia as Office Manager) from 1970-2000. At that time, when the Spragues stepped back from these ministries, the Board of Directors requested that they serve as Minister-At-Large throughout the Pacific Northwest. This they agreed to do, and have continued until the present, helping church leaders, pastors, and Christian workers serve effectively in ministry and outreach.

When Grace Community Church in Elma realized their pastor was taking a leave of absence for seven months to Arizona, they called the Spragues. What a privilege it's been to serve as Interim Pastor since December, seeking to encourage the believers, to begin a series of messages from the book of Romans, and to reach out to the community with the Gospel message.
