MISSIONARY UPDATE

JEFF & SHENY WALKER FELLOWSHIP INTERNATIONAL MISSION Aguascalientes, Mexico



Working with the kids in a poor neighborhood has continued to be a rewarding ministry. Four of the kids come from a home only a few doors away from our rented building for the club meetings. All of the kids show signs of the problems at home. The dad sells drugs and beats his ex-wife

occasionally, even though they are divorced and do not live together. The oldest, America (13), is struggling with suicidal thoughts and has multiple cuts on her arms. The school psychologists and psychiatrists have not been able to help her. Last week she accepted Christ with Sheny (after several months of resisting taking the step)! Pray for America to understand her decision of trusting in Christ alone for her salvation and to grow deep roots in her new faith.

We recently added two more days a week of kids' club to have a deeper impact in the lives of the kids. So we now have kids' club Tuesdays, Thursdays, and Saturdays. Most of the kids come from non-Christian homes with only a mom who has to work and does not have much personal time for the kids. As a result, many of them struggle, and if they are not helped, most end up with messed up lives (drugs, crime, etc.) Some of them barely know how to read and we are helping those we can. Pray also for our camps in the month of April to reach many kids for Christ and help them grow in their faith and feel loved by the camp leaders to make up some for the lack of love they experience at home.

Pray for continued strength and health for us to keep running the camps, kids' clubs, and church ministries. Thank you so much, Alderwood family, for praying for us and for supporting us on the field in Mexico these last forty years.
