MISSIONARY UPDATE

SAM AND JENNY HANSONACI INTERNATIONAL
Aguascalientes, Mexico



A lady and her two girls have been part of our church for close to 10 years. She has an amazing heart for God and others, having run a kid's club, taught in Sunday school, and helped in service projects. Her husband, J*, has been a firefighter and paramedic serving in our city. He has taken drugs on and off

during their marriage, but four years ago he got out of control with his drug use, lost his job and was eventually put in a rehab center. Unfortunately, he didn't stay in long enough to get clean. In February, Sandra reached out to us that the situation at home was no longer healthy. After she and the girls had stayed with us for a week, we were able to get J* into our rehab center that Rodrigo, Gris and Sam helped start over one year ago.

Rodrigo and Gris run the rehab center's day-to-day

activities and are the pastors of our sister church, located in an area with high drug and alcohol use. We have anywhere from 10-20 residents, mostly from Rodrigo's church's neighborhood. After detoxing, the residents join others in a Bible study led by Rodrigo or Sam and round table discussions focused on identifying past problems and building healthy habits going forward.

We are in desperate need of workers to help run the rehab center. Please pray for God to provide qualified, godly people to fill these positions:

- spiritual leaders to run the daily operation of the facility, including leading the Bible studies and discipling the men and women
- a psychologist or counselor to work more individually with some of the residents

Pray for God to give Rodrigo, Gris and Sam strength and wisdom in discipling and mentoring the residents, that J* and other residents could leave with healthy habits established and a love for God, his Word, and serving
