SUPPORT 7 Executive Director



Confusion at first, heavy black smoke starts to fill the home, fear - there's a fire! More smoke - quicker now - pulses race, panic, but where? Why? Get out! 911 is called, first responders rush to the scene, lights and sirens cover the neighborhood - neighbors peek out of their windows, some run out to see how they can help. Fire Command gets on the radio and requests a First Responder Chaplain and the Support 7 Incident Response Team and Emergency Vehicle to care for the displaced homeowners and to be a compassionate liaison between the fire victims and the Fire Marshall's office, Red Cross, Insurance companies, looky-loos, Board-up/restoration solicitors and other strangers who are now part of their world.

As a Support 7 First Responder Chaplain, we pray all the way to each emergency scene "Lord use me! Show me who I'm there to serve, wrap a hedge of protection around all the first responders and this family - Jesus show them Your light, Your peace." We never know exactly what we're walking in to. But recently as I was arriving on a house fire scene, my eyes met a couple of familiar faces, recognition that this day I was there to serve a family from our beloved home church, Alderwood Community. We embraced immediately, trust, gratitude, and prayer - a bit of relief, each of us feeling The Holy Spirit was there, a bright light even in the darkness. Thank you all for the continued prayers for Support 7. We feel the love and support, as we see The Lord working and are amazed as we serve our neighbors in South Snohomish County on-scene during unexpected loss such as natural death, death by suicide, homicide, house/apartment or commercial fire and other tragedies. We are currently deep in planning for our largest fundraiser of the year: the **2nd Annual Support 7 Reception & Auction** on April 22. Please pray for these preparations, for the hearts and minds of all who will attend; first responders, trauma victims, community leaders, churches and businesses.
