Hello Alderwood Family!
We've had a big change in our
family as baby Steven was born on
February 20th. We were blessed
because both Sarah's parents and
Daniel's mom and cousin came
to visit and help in this season of
adjustment. Sarah has transitioned

her role in leading the church's kids outreach to a young Greek lady named Irini. She is an excellent children's ministry worker and we pray God will work mightily through her to touch the lives of the kids in our neighborhood.

In the church-plant recently we have had a number of people coming consistently, acquaintances, who seem spiritually interested. It is clear God is doing something in their hearts, and we are eager to walk alongside them and continue to share the hope of Jesus with them. Three of them are young men, Albanian immigrants raised here in Neos Kosmos. We pray that their goals in life, of partying and making lots of money will change to giving their lives to follow Christ.

Another is a young mom, also Albanian, who loves to bring her kids to every event and Sunday service. Though it seems like she herself isn't listening intently, we know she is drawn to this church-plant community for a particular reason.

There is also an older Greek gentleman who is struggling financially and with his health. He is seeking community and support from the church-plant, and we praise God that he shows up just about every Sunday and has been meeting with Daniel for a weekly Bible study. We also pray for wisdom in knowing how much practical help to offer.
