A week after returning to Sentani, Papua, Indonesia, the second semester began at Hillcrest International School (HIS). It has been wonderful to be back in the classroom with my students. A two year prayer-filled journey through support raising and language school in Bahasa, Indonesia was worth it to be back in the classroom.

My days are filled with teaching secondary classes, attending meetings, organizing Student Council events and everything else that goes along with being in education. But one of my favorite times during the week is Homeroom when I met with my 9th graders and we pray together and talk about what God had done in our lives recently.

One of the bigger events during these past few months was the successful completion of our annual student mission trip called Outdoor Education.
