Thank you for your partnership with us in serving and introducing international students and scholars to Jesus at the University of Oregon! Your gifts enable us to show hospitality, serve felt needs and represent Christ to students; your prayers grant us favor and open hearts. Happy belated Easter!\* We just came

through a spiritually significant season for Christians, Muslims and Jews, as Easter, Ramadan and Passover practically overlapped each other. While most Jewish UO students are Americans, UO's Muslims are mostly international students. So, together with InterVarsity and University Fellowship Church, we facilitated three "peace feasts," including a visit to the Eugene mosque, to build bridges of friendship and discuss beliefs and culture. Please pray for these efforts, and especially for one Eugene convert to Islam who claims to be an ex-Christian pastor. \*\*

Wildlife Safari. We took a mostly-African group to see animals from Africa and around the world. We are blessed by the confidence and boldness of our African Christian student friends. We also enjoyed shopping and tulips with Chinese and Pakistani friends in Woodburn, Oregon.
