MISSIONARY UPDATE

LUKE & KELLY LYONS
GLOBAL SURGE, MANILA



July of 2022 we received some terrible, never want to hear, news. Olga's dad was murdered. Olga, was saved as a teenager in the Philippines about 10 years ago in our ministry. She was followed up, baptized and discipled. As she grew in her faith she also grew in her leadership and began leading ministries at our church and our camp in the Philippines. October, 2014 Olga went on her first ever mission trip alongside ACC to Cambodia. It changed her forever. She returned to Manila, married the man she loved, Darwin (he was saved and discipled in the same manner through our ministry).

A few years later, Olga and Darwin answered God's call to become missionaries and moved to Cambodia to serve as camp directors. Reaching Cambodian teens in the exact same way they were both reached in the Philippines.

Last year in the middle of the night, Olga's dad was stabbed to death. He was the breadwinner of their family by driving a tricycle (motorcycle with a side car) in his neighborhood. He'd been doing it for years. At the funeral all of Olga's family condemned the man. At that point he was on the loose, hiding from the police and her family. Her sister, mother, and brother wanted vengeance. They wanted justice. They wanted their father back.

When Olga stood, and in between sobs she said these words (translated to English) "When you find the man who murdered and took our father from us, tell him... I forgive him. I can't speak for the rest of my family, but you tell him Olga forgives him. In the same way Jesus forgave me."

Talk about the power of the Gospel living and showing through the heart of a young leader.
