Praise God for the successful year for our Christian School. We have 30 Aeta children who graduated this school year. A ceremony was held June 29th - the Aeta parents were very happy to see their children graduating from Kindergarten, Grade 6, and Grade 10. They also pinned the medals of their children who received awards much to their delight and joy.

The Christian School is an institution licensed and recognized by the Philippine government. It is free, that is, we do not charge any tuition. The Aeta children who came from far away stay full time in the Aeta Children's Home where we feed them, cloth them, provide school and medical supplies free of charge. Our mission is to improve the quality of life of the Aetas through Christian Education. The reason the Aeta people are the poorest in our society is that they had no opportunity to go to school. Most parents of the children are illiterate, are being discriminated and oftentimes victims of deception by their non-Aeta neighbors. That is why the Lord has given us a burden to improve their quality of life through the education of their children. Since the school is free of charge, it is operated by faith in God's provision, through the love and generosity of kindhearted people like you. Alderwood helped us build a school for the poor but precious Aeta children. When I visited and spoke at a Sunday service at ACC, the Lord touched the hearts of many people to help the Aeta children. Through ACC donations, a kindergarten building was established for the children in 2016.

Thank you very much for all your faithful support both in prayers and finances. Please know that your labors of love for these Aeta children have not been in vain. Many of them are now teachers, pastors, and missionaries. Some of them are skilled workers such as welders, electrician, and drivers. God richly bless you for your love, kindness and generosity toward these tribal Aetas here in the Philippines.
